

Rankine 2020 Conference- Advances in Cooling, Heating and Power Generation

University of Glasgow, Scotland, UK, 26th- 29th July 2020

The UK will host this unique international conference bringing together the disciplines of Organic Rankine Cycle (ORC) and Refrigeration Air Conditioning and Heat Pumps (RACHP). Designed to encourage the flow of ideas between the two fields, it will provide a forum to discuss the shared environmental challenges being faced, the solutions being proposed and the difficulties in choosing the most efficient working fluids. Delegates will explore research and developments in the closely related fields of power cycles, working fluids and RACHP applications. They will take away insights into new opportunities to deliver efficient, sustainable and environmentally friendly solutions.
