

### **Additional information on the Technical Report Route (TRR) for IOR Members**

This route is for those IOR members who wish to gain Engineering Council (EngC) Registration but don't have the required Academic Qualifications. The table below outline the path which IOR members would follow.

<b>Alternative Route Stages</b>	<b>Fees Due</b>
<b>Technical Report Registration</b> To register onto the Technical Report Route you must complete and submit the Technical Report Application form, which includes your Report Synopsis.	Application
<b>ICP Panel Review</b> The ICP Panel will review your Technical Report Synopsis and will either approve your synopsis or requested additional information.	Administration
<b>Report Writing</b> When you have received notification that your Synopsis has been approved, you can start writing your full Technical Report. Note: Once you have submitted your Synopsis, you can start writing your Engineering Practice Report (EPR), as it will need to be submitted alongside your Technical Report.	
<b>Submit your Reports</b> Your final Technical Report and Registration Application, including your EPR, CV, Development Action Plan and Organisational Chart, will need to be submitted to be reviewed by the assessors.	Assessment
<b>Interview</b> Once your reports have been approved, you will be interviewed for your Technical Report and Professional Review Interview.	Interview
<b>Member and Registration Panel Review</b> You application and the interviewer's recommendation will be sent to the Panel for review.	
<b>Result</b> The Panel results will be sent to you by email. If successful you're the appropriate EngC Registration fee will be taken and the EngC will be notified. Note: You will receive your Registration Certificate from the EngC within 8 weeks.	EngC Registration
