Abstracts should include the following:

- Names and affiliations of authors
- An indication of the corresponding author and one set of contact details.
- 4 to 5 keywords must be provided after the abstract.
- Abstracts should be written in English.

The following deadlines apply:

- Closing date for abstracts 1st October 2021
- Submission of final paper if accepted 15th December 2021

PREPARATION OF FINAL PAPER – Details will be supply when the abstract is accepted.

If your abstract is accepted full papers will become due 15th December 2021. The paper will be subject to a formal review process and authors may need to undertake some revisions as a result. The final papers will be published in the conference proceedings and be distributed at the conference and SCOPUS and Web of Science. The entire manuscript for the final paper (i.e. text, figures, tables, references and abstracts) should not exceed eight (8) pages, or twelve (12) pages for plenary lectures.

All those submitting an abstract should be aware that:

1. Authors must personally present their papers at the conference.

2. All authors shall comply with the strict timetable for abstract and full-paper submittal.

3. All authors shall take into account reviewers' recommendations and comply with the review-process deadlines.

4. All authors shall comply with the document entitled "Guidelines for Authors on the Presentation of Manuscripts" shown below.
